BACON BITS

SERIES NOTES: Rockford allowed seven goals during Friday's meeting, which is just one tally shy of the most the IceHogs have ever surrendered to Chicago during the two teams' series. The Wolves have now scored seven goals against the IceHogs on six occasions all-time (Rockford only has two such games), and tallied their high mark of eight goals on Nov. 24, 2007 in Rosemont. The IceHogs are 1-0-0-0 at Allstate Arena this season and have won three of the last four road game against the Wolves (including playoffs, Rockford has won five of the last six games at Allstate Arena).

BIZARRO HOGS: Rockford has dropped five of its first six overtime games this season following a shootout loss in Milwaukee last night. The IceHogs are 0-4 in the shootout, 1-1 in overtime and rank last in the AHL with a .167 winning percentage in OT games. Last season, Rockford won five of its first six overtime games en route to finishing eighth in the AHL with a 13-8 record in OT games.

DIRTY DOZEN: The IceHogs have scored at least one power-play goal in each of the last 12 games against the Wolves (includes playoffs), dating to Dec. 30 of last season. Rockford is 18-for-60 (30.0%) on the PP during that 12-game streak. The power play has accounted for 44 percent of the Hogs' scoring against the Wolves in that time, with Rockford netting 18 of its 41 goals on the power play.

ONE-MAN WOLFPACK: Anthony Louis led the IceHogs in scoring against Chicago last season (8 points) and has found the scoresheet in each of his first two games of this season's series. Louis has logged a point in 10 of his 13 career games against the Wolves, and combined for 11 total points (5g, 6a) against the team. He also enters tonight with a five-game point streak (3g, 3a) against Chicago.

THE WOLF OF DAHL-STREET: Carl Dahlstrom has logged more points against the Wolves than any other AHL team during his four-year career with the IceHogs. The blueliner paced all Rockford skaters in assists against Chicago last season, and after tallying a helper in Friday's contest, has totaled 11 points (1g, 10a) against the Wolves during his career.

OFFENSIVE OFFENSE: The IceHogs have been limited to two or fewer goals in six straight games, and in eight of the last nine contests since Nov. 7. Rockford enters Sunday ranked 30th of 31 teams in goals per game (2.38) and 28th in total goals (50).

WE PLAY TO WIN THE GAME!: Despite notching a point with a shootout loss last night, the Hogs extended their winless streak to six straight games. The six-game skid ranks as the longest active such streak in the AHL, and second-longest winless streak overall in the league this season (behind San Antonio, 8 games, Oct. 9-26). The last time the IceHogs went winless over 6+ games was Feb. 25 - March 14 during the 2016-17 season (104 games between the two streaks).
