### BACON BITS

**SERIES NOTES:** The IceHogs were shut out by Chicago for the first time since the 2015-16 season (Jan. 2, 2016) following their 4-0 loss to the Wolves in the teams' most recent meeting on Dec. 8. Rockford boasted a streak of 34 consecutive games against the Wolves without a shutout prior to snapping the stretch on Dec. 8. Overall, the all-time series has featured just 12 shutouts through 128 regular-season meetings, with Rockford blanking Chicago seven times and the Wolves shutting out the Hogs in five games.

**IT WAS THE BEST OF TIMES:** Rockford scored a power-play goal in 13 straight games against Chicago before snapping the streak in the most recent game of the series. The IceHogs combined for 19 total PPGs during the streak, with 11 different skaters tallying at least one PPG against the Wolves.

**KEEP YOUR ENEMIES CLOSER** The IceHogs have notched each of their last eight wins by a one-goal margin dating back to Nov. 9 at Milwaukee. Overall, Rockford's nine wins in one-goal games are the fifth-most in the AHL, and its 17 total one-goal games thus far this season are the third-most in the league behind only Bridgeport and Milwaukee (both teams have 19 one-goal games).

**SUPER SOUPY:** Defenseman Andrew Campbell was named the Western Conference's playing captain for the 2019 AHL All-Star Classic on Thursday. Campbell is Rockford's first player to serve as captain at the All-Star Classic, and the All-Star selection is the first of Campbell's 11-year/679-game AHL career.

**USE THE FORS:** Anton Forsberg is unbeaten in four road starts this season, posting a 4-0-0 record with a 1.74 GAA and .935 save percentage in games away from the BMO Harris Bank Center. He enters Friday having limited opponents to two or fewer goals in each of those four road starts this year. Dating back to his final season with Cleveland in 2016-17, Forsberg is unbeaten in regulation over his last seven AHL road games (6-0-1).

**QUALITY OVER QUANTITY:** The IceHogs were outshot by Milwaukee during Wednesday's victory but improved to 12-6-1-3 (.636) when being outshot by opponents this year. Rockford's 12 wins when being outshot are tied for the most in the AHL (also Springfield).

**A RUTTING INTEREST:** Jan Rutta picked up his first career AHL points in Wednesday's win against Milwaukee, tallying an assist and potting his first AHL goal as the game-winning tally in overtime. The IceHogs have now notched points in each of Rutta's first three games with the team (2-0-1-0).

**ANT MAN & THE HOGS:** Anthony Louis extended his season high-tying point streak to four straight games (5a) with two helpers against the Admirals. Louis has posted two four-game streaks this season, and he is currently just one game shy of matching Tyler Sikura's team-high streak from Oct. 6-20.
