### BACON BITS

**SERIES NOTES:** The road team has won each of the first six games in the series with Rockford winning three contests in Rosemont and Chicago notching three victories in Rockford. Each of the IceHogs' top two goal scorers in the series are defenseman after Lucas Carlsson lit the lamp in last night's game. Darren Raddysh and Carlsson have combined for six goals against the Wolves this season. The Wolves have outshot Rockford in each of the six games in this season's series, combining for a 221-160 advantage in shots on goal entering Saturday.

**THE SCHREDDER:** Jordan Schroeder has produced two of his three multi-point efforts on the season against the Wolves and enters tonight's contest as Rockford's leading scorer in the series with six points (1g, 5a) in five games. He has tallied points in 13 of his last 19 games against the Wolves with four multi-point efforts. Schroeder also paces all IceHogs skaters in career scoring against Chicago with 19 points (2g, 17a) in 26 career games.

**THAT'S RAD:** Darren Raddysh picked up an assist last night against Chicago for his team high-tying 20th point (7g, 13a) on the season this year. Raddysh has only once posted a stretch or more than two straight games without tallying a point this season, and his 20 total points are tied for 11th among AHL defenseman. The blueliner is just two points shy of matching his total point production from his 66 games last season.

**ANT MAN & THE HOGS:** Anthony Louis tied the IceHogs season-high point streak with assists in five straight games, and after snapping the streak on Wednesday at Iowa, bounced back with a helper last night against the Wolves. The forward has points in six of his last seven games with seven total assists over that span. He is tied for third in the AHL in helpers over that stretch dating to Dec. 14.

**FOUR SCORE:** Lucas Carlsson scored a goal last night against the Wolves, boosting the Hogs to a 2-1 lead in the second period. Carlsson has six points (4g, 2a) over his last six games, and shares the AHL lead among AHL defensemen in goals with four markers over in that stretch dating to Dec. 15.

**ONE BY ONE:** The IceHogs have picked up each of their last nine wins by a margin of just one goal dating back to Nov. 9 at Milwaukee. Rockford ranks fourth in the AHL in wins in one-goal games with a record of 10-2-2-4 in contests decided by a lone tally.

**AHEAD OF THE CURVE:** Rockford suffered just its third regulation loss when tied or leading after the first period during last night's game against the Wolves (tied 1-1 after the first last night). Including the loss, the IceHogs have notched points in 20 of 23 games when tied or leading after the first period. Rockford is 16-3-1-3 when they conclude the first period without trailing the opposition.
