BACON BITS

SERIES NOTES: The road team won each of the first six games of the series before Rockford snapped the streak with a loss in the most recent meeting in a 2-1 OTL in Rosemont on Dec. 29. The Wolves have outshot Rockford in each of the seven games in this season's series, combining for a 264-181 advantage in shots on goal entering Saturday.

THE SCHREDDER: Jordan Schroeder has produced two of his three multi-point efforts on the season against the Wolves and enters tonight's contest as Rockford's leading scorer in the series with seven points (1g, 6a) in six games. He has tallied points in 14 of his last 20 games against the Wolves with four multi-point efforts. Schroeder also paces all IceHogs skaters in career scoring against Chicago with 20 points (2g, 18a) in 27 career games.

QUICK ON THE TRIGGER: Rockford scored the first goal Friday against Grand Rapids and has now potted the first goal in back-to-back games. The feat marks just the fourth stretch of scoring the first goal in two or more straight games, and is the first such stretch since Dec. 19-21. Overall, Rockford's longest streak of scoring the first goal is four straight games set over the first four games of the season on Oct. 5-14 and matched on Nov. 20-25.

ROAD WOES: The IceHogs enter tonight's road game with a season-high road winless streak of seven straight games. The streak is the longest active road winless streak in the AHL, and is tied with Providence, Ontario and Belleville for the longest overall road winless streak in the league for 2018-19. Rockford is 0-5-1-1 and has been outscored 21-9 on the road in that span.

WILL THE THRILL: William Pelletier scored a goal against Grand Rapids and now has points in three of the last four games. The forward netted just two of his 14 goals last season on home ice, but has now scored each of his two goals this season at the BMO Harris Bank Center.

ON THE EJD OF GLORY: Victor Ejdsell has tallied points in three of four games since returning to the lineup on Jan. 11. The forward currently boasts a season-high three-game point streak (1g, 2a) and has five points (1g, 4a) over his last seven contests dating to Dec. 14.

POWER OUTAGE: Rockford has held scoreless on the power play for the sixth time in seven games following last night's tilt against the Griffins. The IceHogs are just 2-for-24 (8.3%) on the power play over the last seven games, and rank 27th in the league in overall power-play efficiency (14.8%).

LOCKED IN LANKINEN: Goaltender Kevin Lankinen has limited opponents to two or fewer goals in six of his last eight games dating to Nov. 17. The netminder is ninth in the AHL in save percentage and 12th in the league in GAA over that span with a .923 save percentage and 2.23 GAA.
