THE GAME STORY

The Manitoba Moose (20-19-3-2) play their second game in as many nights, visiting the Chicago Wolves (24-15-5-1) at Allstate Arena tonight.

The Moose got back in the win column with a 3-2 overtime win in Milwaukee last night and have points in 10 of 11 games. Chicago has dropped four of five after a 5-2 loss in Rockford last night.

Logan Shaw and Seth Griffith lead the Moose with 31 points each, while Daniel Carr leads the Wolves, and the AHL, with 55 points (22G, 33A) in 39 games.

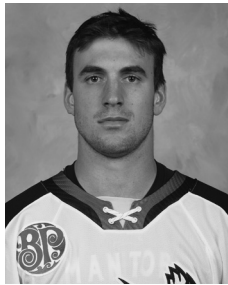

Chicago built up a 3-0 lead before JC Lipon scored twice to get the Moose back within one with 15 minutes left in the third. Brandon Pirri iced the game into an empty net. Ken Appleby made 39 saves in the loss.

Forward Felix Girard scored his first goal as a member of the Moose in last night's win over Milwaukee. The goal gives Girard nine points (1G, 8A) in 39 games this season. The Levis, Que. native leads the Moose with 67 penalty minutes. The veteran centre has 85 points (32G, 53A) in 325 career AHL games.

Head-to-Head

Moose-Wolves History

Including their IHL battles, the Moose have faced off against the Wolves more than any other active team in the AHL. The teams have come together 112 times with the Moose holding a 48-51-5-8 record versus the Wolves.

In the AHL, the teams have met 65 times where Manitoba has a 32-25-4-4 record against Chicago.

NEWS & NOTES

Double Digits

Seth Griffith picked up an assist in last night's win, pushing his assist/point streak to 10 games. Griffith is the first player in the league this season to reach 10 straight games recorded an assist, posting 13 helpers during that span. His point streak is also the longest current run in the AHL. Griffith's 14 points (1G, 13A) over the streak account for 45 per cent of his overall offensive production, 31 points (6G, 25A) this season.

Overtime Winner

The last shot of yesterday's game belonged to Jansen Harkins as he put away the Admirals in overtime. The tally was Harkins' first AHL overtime winner, and adds to a season in which the North Vancouver, B.C. native already had two game winning goals and a shootout winner. Harkins' ninth goal of the season pushes him into sole possession of second on the Moose. His 20.0 shooting percentage ranks second on the club among players with 20 or more games, and is tops among those who have played at least 30.

All the Goals

Logan Shaw scored his 19th goal, and ninth power play tally, of the season last night. Shaw is tied for 13th in the league in goals, and has climbed into a tied for sixth in power play goals. The veteran forward has goals in six of his last eight games, with four of those coming on the power play. Shaw is the only player in the AHL to lead his team by 10 or more goals.

Career Numbers

Defenceman Tucker Poolman tallied a pair of helpers last night for his first multi-point game of the season. The two points brought the East Grand Forks, Minn. product up to 10 points (2G, 8A) on the season to match his rookie total from last season. Poolman has already set new highs in goals, power play goals and games played, while maintaining a better plus/minus rating.

Trading Places

Tonight's game is the first between the Moose and Wolves since Manitoba traded forward Tye McGinn to Chicago, and the Vegas Golden Knights traded defenceman Jimmy Oligny to the Winnipeg Jets. Since joining the Moose, Oligny has two assists in six games, but will miss tonight's game due to injury. McGinn has one assist in six games since joining Chicago.

The Central Division posted a 1-2-0 record in the All-Star Challenge, with Shaw picking up one assist in the three mini-games.

Player of the Week

Goaltender Eric Comrie was named the CCM/AHL Player of the Week for the period ending Jan. 20. Comrie posted a 4-0-0 record, leading AHL goaltenders in wins, saves (131) and minutes played (244). The Edmonton, Alta. native allowed just seven goals, while featuring a 1.72 goals-against average and a 0.949 save percentage in his four starts.
