## Anders Sorensen - Interim Head Coach

Sörensen is in his eighth season (2021-22) as development coach for the Chicago Blackhawks and was named to the Assistant Coach position on January 4, 2019. During the offseason of 2021, he was promoted as the Associated Head Coach and was named the Interim Head Coach of the IceHogs on Nov. 6, 2021 when then Head Coach Derek King was promoted to the Blackhawks. Prior to working with the Blackhawks, the Södertälje, Sweden, native spent the 2014-15 season as head coach of the Chicago Mission U16 club and the 2010-11 season as head coach of the Chicago Mission U18 team. Sorensen was previously an assistant coach with the Swedish Hockey League's Södertälje from 2011-13 before serving as interim head coach in October 2013.

## Jared Nightingale - Assistant Coach

Nightingale served as the IceHogs team captain during the 2013-14 season, his lone playing campaign with the organization. In 67 games, the Jackson, Michigan, native, scored on goal and three assists for four points and led the team with 114 penalty minutes. Overall, he played in 674 professional games in the AHL and ECHL, totaling 102 points (23G, 79A).

Following his playing career, Nightingale moved behind the bench as an assistant coach in the junior hockey ranks starting in 2017-18. Most recently, he served as the assistant coach with the Flint Firebirds of the OHL for the past two seasons, where he helped the club to a 6-5-0 record to start this season. He was also a member of the Saginaw Spirit coaching staff during the 2019-20 season. The former 6-foot-3, 205-pound defenseman was also behind the bench with the US. National Team Development Program in the USHL in 2018-19.

## Peter Aubry - Interim Assistant Coach

Aubry is in his seventh season (2021-22) in the role of developmental goaltending coach and under his leadership, the IceHogs' goaltending corps ranked second in the AHL in save percentage during the 2018-19 season, with Collin Delia, Anton Forsberg, and Kevin Lankinen combining for a .913 save percentage and Delia and Lankinen both recently graduating to the Blackhawks. The Windsor, Ontario, native originally joined the IceHogs organization in 2015 after serving as an assistant coach at Lake Superior State University in 2014-15 and Mercyhurst University from 2011-14.

During his playing career, Aubry played four seasons at Mercyhurst and had a pro career spanning from 2002-11 with stops in the ECHL (Alaska, Johnstown and Texas ), AHL (Saint John ), UHL (Elmira), EIHL (Cardiff and Newcastle ) and Ligue Magnus - France (Les Ducs d'Angers).

## Career Notes:

2020-21: Mitchell returns to the IceHogs for his second full season and 11th professional campaign after appearing in 29 games with the IceHogs last season, adding three goals and two assists for five points and led the club with 44 penalty minutes. His 29 appearances were tied for the most on the team and he finished second with 35 hits. He was named the 13 th team captain in IceHogs history on 2/5/21 and skated in his 500th pro game on 3/13/21 at GR.

Just ahead of the 2020-21 season, the Regina, Saskatchewan, native was named the 13th captain in IceHogs history, his second appointment to the position after serving as the leader of the Hershey Bears of the AHL for three seasons from 2015-18.
A veteran of 446 AHL contests over 10 campaigns, Mitchell holds 121 points ( $60 \mathrm{G}, 61 \mathrm{~A}$ ) while skating with the IceHogs, Bears and Laval Rocket. In 44 games with the IceHogs since joining the team late in the 2019-20 season, he has seven goals and four assists for 11 points.

## Career Notes:

2020-21: Gicewicz helped the University of Massachusetts to their first NCAA championship in program history on Apr. 10, 2021 as the Minutemen defeated St. Cloud State 5-0 at PPG Paints Arena in Pittsburgh, PA. The Orchard Park, New York, native led the club with 17 goals and tied for third with 24 points in 28 games and recorded a hat trick on Mar. 27 vs. Bemidji State to send UMass to the NCAA Frozen Four tournament.

Prior to capturing U.S. college hockey's ultimate prize, Gicewicz attended St. Lawrence University for three seasons (2016-19) before transferring to UMass and missing the 2019-20 season due to injury. In 101 games at St. Lawrence, the 6-foot-3, 212-pound forward totaled 54 points with 21 goals and 33 assists. He was named a team captain in Nov. of 2018, his junior season, and led the club with 19 points and 15 assists in 31 games.

## Career Notes:

2020-21: Acquired by the Blackhawks on Apr. 8, 2021 from the Florida Panthers, Connolly had notched four points (2G, 2A) this year with Florida and added two points ( $1 \mathrm{G}, 1 \mathrm{~A}$ ) with the Blackhawks in 10 games. He scored his 100th career NHL goal on March vs. Detroit. The NHL veteran and member of the 2018 Stanley Cup champion Washington Capitals, Connolly played in 527 career-regular season games with Chicago, Tampa Bay, Boston, Washington and Florida, tallying 194 career points (101G, 93A). Connolly has posted 11 points ( $8 \mathrm{G}, 3 \mathrm{~A}$ ) in 42 career postseason games.

He had career highs in games played (81), goals (22), assists (24) and points (46) during the 2018-19 season with the Capitals. A native of Campbell River, British Columbia, Connolly participated in the 2014 AHL All-Star Game. He represented Canada at back-to-back IIHF World Junior Championship's in 2011 and 2012.

2020-21: Earned 14 points (5G, 9A) in 27 games with the IceHogs. Scored his first pro point (assist) in his pro debut on Feb. 6 vs. Chicago and picked up his first pro goal and added two assists on Feb. 23 vs. Cleveland.

2019-20: Barratt recently completed his junior season at Penn State University where he shared the team lead with 12 goals and was second with 34 points in 34-regular season games.

2018-19: Named First-Team All-Big Ten after his sophomore season. His 43 points (16G, 27A) that season were fourth in the conference, 13th nationally and the third highest single-season point total in program history, while his 16 goals shared ninth. His 1.34 points-pergame ranked fourth in the country and set a new Penn State single-season record.
Barratt, 21, helped Team USA capture a silver medal at the 2019 IIHF World Junior Championship, tallying a goal in seven games. He won a gold medal at the 2017 U-18 World Junior Championship, sharing third on the team with five assists, while also adding a marker in seven games.
