### Wolves Start Weekend Doubleheader vs. Stars

The Wolves take the ice Friday to open a two-game set hosting the Texas Stars. Chicago is coming off a three-in-three week

Chicago is coming off a three-in-three weekend where they went 1-1-1-0, losing the finale 5-1 to lowa on Sunday afternoon.

The Wolves are looking to snap an AHL season-long home losing streak of five games that stretches back to Oct. 29.

Jamieson Rees (two goals, two assists) and Malte Stromwall (goal, two assists) had points in all three games and are each riding four-game point streaks. Rees currently owns the Wolves points lead with 14, and defenseman Anttoni Honka is the only other Chicago player to crack double-digits in points.

Nathan Sucese scored two shorthanded goals last weekend to rank him second in the American Hockey League in that category by Will Bitten of Springfield (three).

Chicago has a .895 team save percentage among the three goalies to have manned the nets this season.

The Wolves continue to be one of the AHL's most disciplined teams, generating penalties against at 10.29 PIM per game, ahead of only Rochester and Milwaukee. Chicago's 124 opponent PIM rank as fewest in the AHL.

Texas went past regulation in both its weekend games in Manitoba, winning Friday and losing Saturday. Veteran goaltender Anton Khudobin ranks in the Top 15 in the AHL in save percentage for the Stars.

#### FACTS AND FIGURES

• The Wolves have successfully killed off 14 of the last 16 penalties against them and now rank ninth in the league in penalty kill percentage (83.6).

• Chicago is allowing the third-most shots per game in the AHL at 33.57.

• The Wolves are generating the fourth-fewest shots per game in the AHL at 27.86.

• Chicago is being outshot at a rate of 5.43 per 60 minutes.

• Chicago is one of four teams with a winning percentage of

.500 or below when scoring first.
