Stockholm's Own

Simon Lundmark logged a goal and an assist in Manitoba's win in Rockford yesterday. The two points represent the second time this campaign the defencemen has notched a multi-point outing. In addition, Lundmark, a second round pick of Winnipeg in 2019, posted his first career AHL game-winning goal. Manitoba has wins in all three games this season when Lundmark scores a goal. The defender has tallied 17 points (3G, 14A) and a plus-four rating in 63 games this season.

Leon the Professional

Leon Gawanke posted a goal in the first period of last night's contest. The tally was the defenceman's 20th of the season, which makes Gawanke one of only two defencemen in the AHL to achieve the feat this season. It's the first time the AHL has featured 20-goal defencemen since the 2018-19 campaign.
