## Griffins at Wolves

Fifth of eight meetings overall, second of four at Allstate Arena...Grand Rapids has faced Chicago 198 times in the regular season dating back to their IHL days, the second-most of any Griffins opponent (Milwaukee, 218)...The Griffins are one win away from 100 against Chicago in the all-time series during the regular season...Grand Rapids has points in seven of the last eight meetings (5-1-0-2) against Chicago, dating back to March 12, 2023...The Wolves are 2-4-1-3 in their last 10 games and are on a seven-game winless streak (0-3-1-3)...The Griffins are 5-3-1-1 in their last 10 games and are on a three-game winning streak...On the road, Grand Rapids is 12-12-3-2 and Chicago is 10-14-3-3 at home...Since the 2019-20 season, Grand Rapids is just 15-23-2-2 (.405) against the Wolves and has been outscored 153-114. Also since the 2019-20 season, the Griffins are 9-12-0-0 (.429) against the Wolves in Chicago and have been outscored 82-63...The Wolves ranks second in the AHL with a power-play percentage of 21.5%, while their penalty kill is tied for fifth at 83.8%...Grand Rapids is tied for 24th with a power-play rate of 17.3% and is tied for 12th with a penalty kill at 82.1%...With a 5-3-1-1 record against the Wolves last season, the Griffins finished above the .500 mark against Chicago for the first time since the 2016-17 campaign...Chicago's Chris Terry skated for the Griffins from 2018-20 and totaled 112 points (50-62—112) in 126 games.

## Last Time Out

The Griffins clinched a spot in the Calder Cup playoffs and set a new franchise record for the longest home point streak at 17 consecutive games (12-0-3-2) in a 5-2 victory over the Cleveland Monsters at Van Andel Arena on Wednesday. **Sebastian Cossa** now owns the franchise record for the longest point streak by a goaltender with a point 16 straight games from Jan. 19-March 27 (11-0-5). Grand Rapids' previous longest home point streak came as a 16-game run (13-0-3-0) from Jan. 9, 2004-Feb. 27, 2004. Marc Lamothe most recently held the longest point streak by a goaltender, as he posted a 9-0-4-2 (W-L-T-OTL) record from Oct. 19, 2002-Nov. 30, 2002. **Jonatan Berggren** extended his point streak (4-6--10) to seven games with two points (1-1--2), which tied the longest point streak this season by a Griffin. **Taro Hirose's** two points (1-1--2) put him in sole possession of sixth place on the Griffins' all-time scoring list with 198 points.

## This Date in Griffins History

## The Promised Land

On Wednesday, the Griffins clinched their 18th playoff berth in 28 seasons with a 5-2 victory over the Cleveland Monsters at Van Andel Arena. The Griffins return to the Calder Cup Playoffs for the first time since 2019, ending a drought that included two postseasons (2020 and 2021) that were canceled due to COVID-19. This marks the team's earliest clinching date since 2017, when the AHL's eventual Calder Cup champions secured their spot on March 26. Clinching a spot with 25 days remaining in the regular season also marked the earliest the Griffins have clinched relative to the date of their finale since 2006, when the AHL's regular-season champions locked up their berth with 34 days to play. Exactly three months prior to clinching, the sixth-place Griffins were tied for the fourth-lowest points percentage in the AHL, bringing a 9-13-3-1 record (.423) into their first game after the Christmas break. They've since posted a 23-5-4-3 mark (.757), solidifying their hold on second place in the Central Division and becoming the fourth team to secure a berth in the Calder Cup Playoffs.

## Back to Our Old Self

After enduring a season-high five-game winless skid from March 2-12 (0-2-2-1), the Griffins have returned to form with wins in three straight games and in five of their last six contests. The Griffins saw their 18-game point streak (13-0-3-2 from Jan. 13-March 2) come to an end on March 4 in Cleveland, which was one game shy of tying the franchise record of 19 contests (Feb. 4-March 20, 2015 15-0-3-1) and is the second-longest run in the AHL this season. The Griffins' active 17-game home point streak (12-0-3-2) is a new franchise record, beating out the previous mark of 16 games that was established from Jan. 9-Feb. 27, 2004 and is also longest run in the AHL this season. Grand Rapids' nine-game road point streak (8-0-0-1) from Dec. 27-Feb. 17 was their longest since an 11-game run (9-0-1-1) from Jan. 29-March 12, 2015 and is tied for the second longest in the AHL this season. The Griffins have secured at least a point in 32 of their last 38 contests (24-6-5-3). The Griffins are 23-5-4-3 (.757) since Christmas and have had a trio of winning streaks of five or more games in the same season for the first time since 2013-14. Grand Rapids has points in 23 of its last 27 games (18-4-3-2) inside Van Andel Arena and has points in 13 of its past 17 road appearances (10-4-2-1). The Griffins have been solid at home with a 20-6-4-2 mark, outscoring their opponents 101-73. Grand Rapids has battled on the road this season, earning points in 12 of its last 15 games to move to 12-12-3-2 away from home.

## Records are Meant to be Broken

The Griffins have rewritten the record book in multiple categories this season. Most recently on Wednesday, Grand Rapids set a new franchise record with a point in its 17th straight home game, breaking a 16-game record that was established more than 20 years ago, from Jan. 9-Feb. 27, 2004. The home point run is the second franchise-record streak that the Griffins have tied in the last two months, piggybacking their seven-game road winning streak from Dec. 27, 2023-Feb. 2, 2024. The Griffins also rattled off an 18-game point streak from Jan. 13-March 2 (13-0-3-2), which was one game shy of tying the franchise record of 19 contests (Feb. 4-March 20, 2015 15-0-3-1). Now 11-0-5 since Jan. 19, **Sebastian Cossa** holds the franchise record for the longest point streak by a goaltender at 16 outings, beating Marc Lamothe's previous record of 15 games (9-0-4-2 (W-L-T-OTL)) set from Oct. 19-Nov. 30, 2002. Finally, the Griffins have had a trio of winning streaks of five or more games in the same season for the first time since 2013-14.

## Black Magic

As the regular season inches closer to its completion, the Griffins have clinched a playoff berth and a winning record, and are in second place in the Central Division with a 32-18-7-4 record and 75 points with just 11 games remaining.

## Sea Bass Fishing

**Sebastian Cossa** is on a franchise-record 16-game point streak from Jan. 19-March 27 (11-0-5), beating Marc Lamothe's previous record of 15-games (9-0-4-2 (W-L-T-OTL)) set from Oct. 19-Nov. 30, 2002. Since returning from the holiday break on Dec. 27, Cossa has a 13-1-5 ledger with a 2.08 goals against average and a .923 save percentage. The former 15<sup>th</sup> overall pick by the Red Wings in the 2021 NHL Entry Draft has allowed more than two goals just six times in his past 19 games. Through 32 contests, Cossa is 17-7-8 with one shutout to go along with a 2.53 goals against average and a .912 save percentage. Cossa ranks fifth among rookie goaltenders in both goals against average and save percentage. Cossa named the Howies Hockey Tape/AHL Player of the Week on Feb. 26 when he posted a 2-0-0 record with one shutout to go along with a 1.00 GAA and a .970 save percentage from Feb. 21-25. On Feb. 21, the 21-year-old collected his first AHL shutout with 28 saves in a 1-0 victory over the Texas Stars, lifting Grand Rapids past Texas into second place in the Central Division and becoming just the third Griffins rookie to record a shutout over the last nine seasons. Cossa went on to stop 37 shots on Feb. 25, including 14 in the third period, to help the Griffins snap Milwaukee's 19-game winning streak and extend Grand Rapids' point streak to 15 games (11-0-2-2).

## Kasper the Friendly Ghost

Last weekend, rookie **Marco Kasper** enjoyed three points (1-2—3) in two games and now has five points (2-3—5) in his last five outings. The 2022 eighth overall pick by the Red Wings also has nine points (5-4—9) in his last 13 games and is tied for fourth on the roster with 31 points (12-19—31) in 60 contests. The 19-year-old was named the Howies Hockey Tape/AHL Player of the Week for the period ending on Jan. 21 when he totaled five points (3-2—5) in two games at Manitoba. The Klagenfurt, Austria, native made his NHL debut with the Red Wings as an 18-year-old on April 2, 2023 at the Toronto Maple Leafs.

## Tower of Terror

**Elmer Soderblom**, standing at 6-foot-8, enjoyed a three-game point streak (2-1—3) from March 16-20. The tallest player to ever compete for the Griffins also has five points (4-1—5) in his last seven outings and seven points (5-2—7) in his last 12 appearances. In 56 games this season, the Gothenburg, Sweden, native has 27 points (12-15—27), eight penalty minutes and a plus-three rating. Last campaign, the 22-year-old posted eight points (5-3—8) in 20 games with the Griffins on top of producing eight points (5-3—8) in 21 games with the Detroit Red Wings. Soderblom was selected with the 159th overall pick by Detroit in the 2019 NHL Entry Draft.

## Johnny Bravo

**Jonatan Berggren**, reassigned to Grand Rapids by Detroit on Monday, is on an active seven-game point streak (4-6—10) from Feb. 24-March 27 and has 24 points (12-12—24) in his last 20 games from Jan. 13-March 27. Berggren also has 30 points (13-17—30) in his last 25 outings and 33 points (15-18—33) in his last 28 contests from Dec. 15-March 27. The 23-year-old leads the roster in points (20-28—48), assists (28) and goals (20) through 44 appearances this season. The Enkoping, Sweden, product became the seventh-fastest player to reach 100 points as a Griffin, doing so in just his 106th game on Jan. 26 against Belleville. Berggren has a combined 119 points (45-74—119) in 121 career AHL appearances from 2021-24, collecting an assist during his 100th game as a Griffin on Jan. 10 against Milwaukee. During his rookie season with the Griffins in 2021-22, Berggren broke Grand Rapids' rookie single-season scoring record with 64 points (21-43—64) in 70 games, five more points than the previous record held by Teemu Pulkkinen (2013-14).

## It's Taco Time

**Taro Hirose** enjoyed a three-game assist streak from March 12-16 (0-4—4), which was one game shy of tying his season-high assist mark set from Nov. 17-27 (0-5—5). Hirose, who is in his fifth season as a Griffin, has nine points (2-7—9) in his last 10 outings. The Calgary, Alberta, native has logged a total of 33 points (8-25—33) in 45 appearances this season, after having missed 12 straight games from Dec. 29-Jan. 27 due to rehabbing an injury. On Wednesday, the 27-year-old passed Tomas Tatar for sixth place on the Griffins' all-time points list with 198 and his 149 assists rank third in franchise history.

## Age is Wisdom

Veteran forwards **Zach Aston-Reese**, **Joel L'Esperance** and **Dominik Shine** have found a groove as of late. Aston-Reese is on a three-game goal streak from March 20-27 and now has 10 points (6-4—10) in his last 14 games. L'Esperance tallied an assist in both games last weekend and has eight points (3-5—8) in his last 13 appearances. Finally, Shine is on a season-high six-game point streak (2-6—8), a team-best five-game assist run and has nine points (3-6—9) in his last 10 outings. Shine has set a new career high with 33 points, while also setting a new career best with 23 assists. Combined, the trio has amassed 422 points (212-210—422) in 835 AHL games over 18 campaigns.

## Matty Ice

On Feb. 21, **Matt Luff** made his season debut after rehabbing an injury suffered in training camp that kept him sidelined for the first 45 games of the season. Luff is on an active six-game point streak from March 15-27 (3-5—8), and now has 12 points (5-7—12) in his last 11 contests. Last season, the 26-year-old posted 25 points (8-17—25) and six penalty minutes in 28 games with the Griffins on top of producing four points (2-2—4) in 19 outings with the Detroit Red Wings. The Windsor, Ontario, native has 157 points (62-95—157) in 213 career AHL outings from 2016-24.

## Clutch Hutch

Veteran goaltender **Michael Hutchinson** has been solid for the Griffins this year, posting a 14-11-3 mark with two shutouts in 29 games to go along with a 2.77 goals against average and an .896 save percentage. The 33-year-old enjoyed a seven-game point streak from Jan. 13-March 1 (5-0-2). Since returning from the holiday break on Dec. 27, Hutchinson has accumulated a 9-4-2 record with one shutout, an .898 save percentage and a 2.60 goals against average. The Barrie, Ontario, native has an all-time AHL record of 120-82-23 with a 2.60 goals against average and a .914 save percentage. Hutchinson has also appeared in 154 NHL contests, showing a 2.94 goals against average and a .902 save percentage.

## Thou Shall Not Pass

The Griffins' defense has been much improved since the holiday break, allowing an average of 2.46 goals per game from Dec. 27-March 27. Prior to the holiday break, Grand Rapids allowed 3.31 goals per game from Oct. 13-Dec. 20. The Griffins have allowed a total of 172 goals through 61 games this season, which ranks second in the Central Division and seventh in the AHL. Grand Rapids is also ninth on the circuit with 2.82 goals against per game, which is second in the division trailing only Milwaukee (2.62, 4th). Netminders **Sebastian Cossa** (2.53) and **Michael Hutchinson** (2.77) each possess a goals against average below 3.00. Defensemen **Albert Johansson** (+10), **Wyatt Newpower** (+9), **Antti Tuomisto** (+7), **Simon Edvinsson** (+5), **Radim Simek** (+4), **Eemil Viro** (+4), **Brogan Rafferty** (+3), **Josiah Didier** (+2) and **William Wallinder** (+1) and all have a positive plus-minus rating.

## No Need for Extra Bodies

Last season, the Griffins used a franchise-record 49 players, which included a franchise-record eight goaltenders. The 49 players last campaign beat out the previous record of 48 set during the 2021-22 season. However, it has been much different this season, as the Griffins have not had a single skater compete on a professional tryout. Grand Rapids has used just four goaltenders this season, with two of them suiting up for just one game (John Lethemon & Ville Husso). The team has also used just 30 skaters throughout the season, a drastic change from the 49 and 48 players used in the past two seasons, respectively.

## Like Father, Like Son

Recently acquired center **Curtis Hall** is the son of former Griffins center Mike Hall, who played seven games for Grand Rapids during the 2000-01 campaign, scoring one goal. They are the third father-son duo to have played for the Griffins, joining Chris (2008-09) and Jake (2018-19) Chelios, and Derek (1999-01; 2002-04) and D.J. (2021-22) King. Family ties have been a common theme throughout the franchise's history, as five sets of brothers have suited up for the Griffins: Sheldon (2001-03) and Wade (2001-02) Brookbank; Valtteri (2005-07) and Ilari (2010-11) Filppula; Kevin (1999-00; 03-04), Kelly (1999-00) and Kip (2000-02; 04-05; 06-07) Miller, along with cousin Drew (2016-17); Todd (1996-98; 99-00; 01-02) and Jeff (1996-97; 03-04; 05-06) Nelson; and Givani (2016-17; 18-21; 22-23) and Gemel (2021-22) Smith.

## Crunch Time

The Griffins have excelled during the third period of games this season, as they have outscored their opponents 76-49 in the final frame and outshot their opponents 571-541. Grand Rapids has six wins when trailing after the second period, which is tied for fourth in the AHL. The Griffins also have a 35-24 shot advantage in overtime this campaign. However, Grand Rapids is just 5-11 in games decided past regulation (3-7 in OT, 2-4 in SO). The Griffins' 18 losses in regulation this season are tied for the third fewest in the AHL, while their seven overtime defeats and four shootout losses are both tied for the fifth most.

## Oh, It's You Again

The Griffins are in second place in the Central Division with a 32-18-7-4 record and 75 points, and have clinched a playoff berth for the 18th time in 28 seasons. All of Grand Rapids' remaining 11 games will be against the Central Division. The Griffins have done well against their division rivals, as they are 25-11-3-2 (.671) with a plus-21 scoring margin against the Central Division. Grand Rapids is undefeated this season against Iowa (6-0-0-0). Chicago and Rockford will be the Griffins' most frequent opponents down the stretch, as there are still four meetings remaining against each franchise.

## Pucks on Net

The Griffins have done well when outshooting their opponents this season with a 17-3-4-4 (.750) record compared to a 14-14-3-0 (.500) mark when they are being outshot. Grand Rapids is 19-5-3-4 (.726) when producing at least 30 shots and 23-9-5-2 (.679) when it keeps its opponents under 29 shots. The Griffins rank 17th in the AHL with 29.5 shots per game, while they concede the seventh fewest in the league at 28.1. The Griffins are averaging 28.9 shots per game in their last 10 outings, while giving up an average of 26.2.

## Under Three is Key

Unsurprisingly, the Griffins have done well in games where they have scored four or more goals, going 23-1-2-0 (.923). Although, when scoring three goals or less the team is just 9-17-5-4 (.386). Grand Rapids has reached the four-goal mark in eight of its last 15 outings. On the flip side, Grand Rapids is just 8-15-7-3 (.394) when allowing at least three goals, compared to a 24-3-0-1 mark (.875) when allowing two goals or less. In their last 15 appearances, the Griffins have allowed three or more goals seven times.

**DAN WATSON  
HEAD COACH**

The Detroit Red Wings named Dan Watson head coach of the Griffins on June 14, 2023. Watson became the 12th head coach in franchise history after serving six seasons as head coach of the ECHL's Toledo Walleye.

The 44-year-old Watson guided Toledo to a 45-19-5-3 (0.681) record last season before going 9-4 in the Kelly Cup Playoffs to reach the Western Conference Finals. He has been with the Red Wings organization for the past 14 seasons, holding multiple roles with the Walleye since the team's inception. An assistant coach from 2009-14, he then served two seasons (2014-16) as Toledo's associate head coach alongside head coach Derek Lalonde, who just completed his first season behind the Red Wings' bench. Watson was named head coach in July 2016 and also served as director of hockey operations during the 2020-21 ECHL campaign in which Toledo did not participate due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Watson never missed the playoffs as head coach, reaching the Kelly Cup Finals twice (2019 and 2022) and leading Toledo to three division titles (2016-17, 2017-18 and 2021-22), three 100-point seasons (2016-17, 2017-18 and 2021-22), two regular season championships (2016-17 and 2021-22), and four Western Conference Finals berths (2017, 2019, 2022 and 2023). In 2016-17, he garnered the John Brophy Award as the ECHL's Coach of the Year in his first year as head coach, when the Walleye won the Central Division behind a franchise-record 51 wins (51-17-2-2, 0.736) and reached the Western Conference Finals.

As a head coach, the Glencoe, Ontario, native possesses a 272-112-22-13 (0.691) ledger during the regular season and a 51-34 (0.600) mark over only five playoff campaigns (the 2020 postseason was canceled due to COVID-19). Watson coached 56 future or former Griffins and nine All-ECHL Team members since becoming Toledo's head coach in 2016, including 2023 ECHL Goaltender of the Year John Lethemon. Over his 14-year tenure, Watson helped guide the Walleye to a 523-318-46-36 (0.611) regular season mark and Toledo reached five conference finals and two Kelly Cup Finals, all within the team's last seven playoff runs.

The fastest coach in ECHL history to reach 100 wins and the winningest head coach in Walleye history, Watson was chosen to coach in the ECHL All-Star Game in both 2017 and 2022.

An undrafted defenseman out of the Ontario Hockey League, Watson signed as a free agent with the Columbus Blue Jackets in 2000 and began his pro career with the Syracuse Crunch in 2000-01, collecting seven points (3-4-7) in 59 games. Throughout four AHL seasons with Syracuse (2000-03), the Cleveland Barons (2002-04) and Providence Bruins (2003-04), he accumulated 27 points (8-19-27) in 193 appearances.

Watson also saw action in four campaigns at the ECHL level with the Dayton Bombers (2001-02), Long Beach Ice Dogs (2004-06, as captain) and the Toledo Storm (2006-07). Watson, who was named the 2004-05 ECHL Defensive Player of the Year with the Ice Dogs, also competed in the United Hockey League with the Elmira Jackals (2000-01), Columbus Stars (2003-04) and the Kalamazoo Wings (2003-04).

Watson played his junior career with the OHL's Sarnia Sting from 1996-2000 and amassed 59 points (9-50-59) in 212 contests, appearing in the OHL All-Star Game during the 1998-99 season.

**STEPH JULIEN**  
**ASSISTANT COACH**

The Detroit Red Wings announced the hiring of Steph Julien as an assistant coach of the Griffins on June 26, 2023.

During the 2022-23 season, Julien was named the Quebec Major Junior Hockey League (QMJHL) Coach of the Year as well as the QMJHL General Manager of the Year when he helped lead the Sherbrooke Phoenix to a Central Division title and a trip to the QMJHL semifinals with a 50-13-3-2 (0.772) regular-season record. Julien also guided Canada's U18 squad to a gold medal at the 2022 Hlinka Gretzky Cup as head coach and earned another gold medal as an assistant for Team Canada at the 2023 World Junior Championship.

In 2022, Julien coached Canada's Black U17 squad to a third-place finish at the World Under-17 Hockey Challenge. He began his national coaching career in 2017 when he served as an assistant coach for Team Canada at the 2017 World Junior Championship, earning a silver medal.

Julien has spent his entire coaching career with Sherbrooke, serving as an assistant coach from 2012-16 before being named head coach midway through the 2015-16 campaign. The Shawinigan, Quebec, native garnered his first QMJHL Coach of the Year recognition during the 2019-20 campaign when Sherbrooke won the QMJHL regular-season title with a 51-8-3-1 mark (0.841). As head boss, Julien notched a 262-161-24-17 record (0.609) with three division titles and one league championship.

In 2022-23, Tyson Hinds was named the QMJHL Top Defensemen while Ethan Gauthier was named the QMJHL Top Pro Prospect under the guidance of Julien. He also propelled Joshua Roy to the top scorer in the QMJHL during the 2021-22 campaign with 119 points (51-68—119) in 66 games. In total, Julien has served as head coach for three QMJHL First All-Star Team members, four second-team honorees and three honorable mentions.

Julien also served as general manager for Sherbrooke for the past three campaigns (2020-23), accumulating a 104-47-6-6 ledger (0.675). In 2022-23, when he was named the QMJHL General Manager of the Year, Julien acquired goaltender Olivier Adam, forwards Jakub Brabenc and Jacob Melanson, and defenseman Marc-Andre Gaudet. Adam went on to show a 20-3-1 record along with a 2.09 GAA, while the skaters combined for 125 points (41-84—125) in 93 games.

The QMJHL's Defenseman of the Year in 1994-95 with the Sherbrooke Faucons, Julien was twice named a QMJHL First Team All-Star (1992-93 and 1994-95) and was selected a Second Team All-Star in 1993-94. The 49-year-old went on to collect 667 points (205-462—667) in 775 professional games from 1995-2012, playing the majority of his career overseas in Austria, France, Germany, Italy and Switzerland. He competed in one pro season in the United States with the Pensacola Ice Pilots of the ECHL, collecting 38 points (13-25—38) and 91 penalty minutes in 69 outings in 1996-97. He spent the most time in the DEL, the top hockey league in Germany, playing nine seasons and serving as captain for EHC München in the final two campaigns of his pro career from 2010-12.

**BRIAN LASHOFF**  
**ASSISTANT COACH**

The Detroit Red Wings announced the hiring of Brian Lashoff as an assistant coach of the Griffins on June 26, 2023.

Lashoff begins his coaching career two months after retiring from professional hockey. The 32-year-old spent all or part of 14 seasons (2008-13; 2014-23) on the Griffins' blue line, including the last three as the team's captain, and seven campaigns (2012-15; 2016-20) with the Detroit Red Wings. Lashoff was a key component of Grand Rapids' Calder Cup championship teams in both 2013 and 2017, joining Nathan Paetsch and Mitch Callahan as the franchise's only two-time cup champions. He served as a playing captain at the 2023 AHL All-Star Classic, marking his first career all-star nod, and he won a gold medal with Team USA at the 2010 World Junior Championship.

The Albany, N.Y., native ranks second on the Griffins' all-time games played list with 628, compiling 132 points (32-100—132) and 329 penalty minutes. He's one of only four defensemen and 12 skaters to record 100 career assists for Grand Rapids, and only two Griffins blueliners have tallied more than his 132 points (Richards 238, Paetsch 142).

Lashoff has also contributed 20 points (5-15—20) and 34 PIM in 75 playoff games for Grand Rapids, marking the second-most postseason appearances in Griffins history (Paetsch 78). He also ranks among the franchise's all-time playoff leaders with two unassisted goals (T1st) and one shorthanded goal (T1st).

Lashoff became the 126th Griffins alumnus to play in the NHL when he made his debut with Detroit on Jan. 21, 2013 against the Columbus Blue Jackets, scoring a goal in the process. The defensemen accumulated 15 points (2-13—15) in 136 regular-season NHL games and logged another eight contests during the Stanley Cup Playoffs.

Including a three-game stint with the ECHL's Toledo Walleye during his first full pro season in 2010-11, Lashoff played his entire career within the Red Wings organization after making his pro debut with the Griffins in 2008-09 at the age of 18.

After playing junior hockey with Kingston and Barrie of the Ontario Hockey League, the undrafted Lashoff suited up for 767 professional regular-season games and registered 148 points (34-114—148) and 394 PIM.

Lashoff resides in Ada with his wife Nicolina and 2-year-old daughter Maeve.

**ROOPE KOISTINEN**  
**GOALTENDING DEVELOPMENT COACH**

The Detroit Red Wings on July 3, 2023, announced the hiring of Roope Koistinen (ROH-peh KOI-stih-NIHN) as the goaltending development coach of the Grand Rapids Griffins.

Koistinen has been with Karpat's youth programs in Finland since the 2014-15 campaign, serving in multiple roles for the club. In 2022-23, Karpat U20 allowed the third-fewest goals in the SM-sarja U20 league in Finland with 48 goals allowed in 23 outings (2.09 GAA) with Koistinen as its goaltending coach. The 30-year-old also garnered a 2023 U17 World Hockey Challenge bronze medal with Team Finland, serving as the team's goaltending coach. As an assistant coach for Finland's U17 team, he collected another bronze medal at the 2023 European Youth Olympic Winter Festival.

From 2015-19, the Kiiminki, Finland, native served as the goaltending coach for Karpat's U18 and U20 clubs before holding the director of goaltending position with the same programs from 2019-21. He returned as the goaltending coach for Karpat's U18 and U20 teams from 2021-23. In 2018-19, Koistinen helped guide Karpat U20 to a U20 SM-liiga championship as its goaltending coach with a 32-13-5-2 ledger and just 121 goals allowed (2.33 GAA), the fewest in the league by 17 goals. In total from 2014-23, Koistinen won three league titles, four silver medals and two bronze medals with Karpat's youth programs.

Koistinen has also been part of Finland's coaching staff for its youth national teams since the 2018-19 season. He served as goaltending coach for Finland U16 from 2018-19 and 2021-22, before earning a spot as goaltending coach for Finland U17 from 2019-20 and 2022-23. In 2020-21, Koistinen finished in fourth place as Finland's goaltending coach at the 2021 U18 World Championship.

Koistinen spent his entire playing career with KKP's youth teams in Finland. He began his career in 2008-09 with KKP U17 in the U17 SM-sarja division in Finland, posting a 4.11 goals against average in 15 appearances. Koistinen competed in his final season during the 2013-14 campaign with KKP U20 in the U20 Aluedivisioona league, compiling a 3.50 GAA and a 0.921 save percentage in two appearances.

Erich Junge will embark on his second season as the video coach for the Grand Rapids Griffins, helping the staff prepare, evaluate and assess their game both as a team and as individuals.

A native of Ballwin, Mo., Junge most recently served as a volunteer assistant coach at Bemidji State University during the 2021-22 season. Junge helped guide the Beavers to the CCHA Playoff championship game before being bested by No. 1 ranked Minnesota State, 2-1 in overtime.

Prior to joining Bemidji State, Junge spent the 2020-21 campaign as the volunteer director of player development for Ohio University. The 25-year-old also served as the video coach for Ohio for four seasons from 2016-20.
