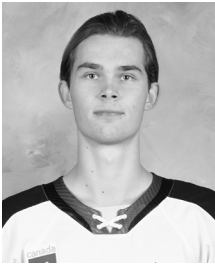

THE GAME STORY			
The Manitoba Moose (25-29-1-1) rematch with the Chicago Wolves (21-28-3-3) at Allstate Arena on Saturday evening. Puck drop is scheduled for 7 p.m. CT between the two clubs.			
Manitoba beat Chicago 3-2 in a shootout yesterday and sports a record of 7-1-0-0 over the past eight. Chicago's loss Friday night brings the club to a mark of 4-5-0-1 over the past 10 contests.			
The Moose are paced by Brad Lambert (18G, 23A) and Kyle Capobianco (8G, 33A), who each have 41 points. The Wolves are led by forward Rocco Grimaldi, who has recorded 53 points (28G, 25A) in 55 games through the 2023-24 season.

Previous Game

Manitoba faced Chicago on Friday and notched a 3-2 shootout victory. Chicago opened the scoring in the middle frame with a shorthanded tally off the stick Max Comtois. The Moose struck back just over a minute later with a shorthanded tally of their own courtesy of Ville Heinola. Chicago reclaimed the lead 19 seconds later with a power play marker from Comtois for his second goal of the stanza. The Moose tied the contest a second time early in the third. Nicholas Jones found twine past Adam Scheel 2:48 into the period to knot the game 2-2. With neither side willing to budge, after 60 minutes, the contest shifted into overtime. Chicago outshot Manitoba 5-3 in the extra frame, but neither Thomas Milic or Scheel gave an inch, moving the game into the shootout. In the shootout, Jeff Malott notched the winner and Milic stopped all five Chicago shooters he faced as the Moose picked up the road victory.



Who's Trending?

Henri Nikkanen tallied a pair of assists in yesterday's victory. The multi-point outing is the forward's second of the season. The Mikkeli, Finland product is riding a two-game point streak and has posted seven points (3G, 4A) over his past six games. Winnipeg's 2019 fourth round selection is tied for the team lead with a plus-seven rating in March.

Moose-Wolves History

Including their IHL battles, the Moose have faced off against the Wolves more than any other active team in the AHL.

Nicholas Jones leads Manitoba and has posted three points (2G, 1A) against the Wolves, while Chicago is paced by Rocco Grimaldi, who has notched five points (2G, 3A) in five games.

The teams have come together 135 times with the Moose holding a 61-58-6-8 record versus the Wolves.

In the AHL, the teams have met 101 total times where Manitoba has a 53-38-8-4 mark against Chicago through those contests.

NEWS & NOTES

Jones Knows
Nicholas Jones posted two points (1G, 1A) in yesterday's road win over Chicago. The forward, who re-signed a two-year contract with Manitoba in 2022, notched his third multi-point game of the season in the victory. Jones has 14 points (6G, 8A) in 40 contests with the Moose this season. The Edmonton, Alta. product has cleared at least 10 points in all five full AHL seasons he participated in. Jones is closing in on an AHL milestone 98 career points (34G, 64A) in 276 games split between Hartford and Manitoba.

Third Period Spark
The Moose, coming off a 3-2 shootout win last night, scored the only goal of the third period, a tally from Nicholas Jones. Over the past eight games, in which Manitoba has produced a mark of 7-1-0-0, the Moose have outscored their opposition by a 20-5 margin in the final 20 minutes of play. A total of 12 of those tallies came at even strength, three by way of the power play and the final five were scored into an empty net. Over the stretch, which reaches back to Manitoba's win over Calgary on Feb. 24, Axel Jonsson-Fjallby paces the forwards with seven points (4G, 3A) and Ville Heinola leads the defenders with four points (1G, 3A) in the third period.

End of the Road, For Now
Tonight's game marks the end of a six-game road swing, and run of 15 games out of the past 21 away from Canada Life Centre. The Moose thrived during the stretch, claiming a 10-3-0-1 record over the past 14 road contests. This trip, Manitoba is 4-1-0-0 through five games. At the start of the stretch of 21 games, the Moose were 12-23-1-0 and last in the AHL. Now the Moose are just four wins below the .500 mark at 25-29-1-1, and hold a four-point lead for the Central Division's final playoff spot. With this road-heavy segment coming to a close, the Moose play 10 of their final 15 games on home ice.

Point Streakin'
Ville Heinola found twine last night in Chicago. With the goal, Heinola's second career AHL shorthanded tally, the Honkajoki, Finland product is now riding a five-game point streak. That ties the defender for the longest stretch of his career, with the previous streak occurring in 2021-22. Over the stretch, the defenceman has produced six points (3G, 3A) and now has 15 points (6G, 9A) in 25 games this season. Heinola, a 2019 Winnipeg first round pick, has recorded 90 career points (19G, 71A) in 136 games and is one point shy of matching former Moose defender Declan Chisholm for eighth overall in franchise points by a defenceman.

The defender recorded 83 points (21G, 62A) in his first 400 contests. In addition to the 400 AHL games, Sautner has also played in 23 NHL contests, all with Vancouver, and registered three assists.
Hats Off to You Jeff Malott recorded his first professional hat-trick on March 3 in Milwaukee. It was the first Moose hat-trick since April 30/22. In the game, Malott jumped past Greg Pankewicz for sixth on the franchise goals leaderboard. The Waterdown, Ont. product is in rare company around the AHL as well, ranking in the top-10 among all skaters for goals scored since he entered the league in 2020-21.
